



A72 - nice start but beware between Drochil Castle and Blyth Bridge. Things get tight, no lines so use the telegraph poles as a guide. Road surface worn. **23**

Peebles - The Royal Burgh on the Tweed providing sustenance for you and your machine. A great start.

A701 - After Broughton to Tweedsmuir - Lots of bends. Great, but remember to read all the road. **8**

A708 - Yarrow Valley opens out but don't get caught taking in the view as the bends tighten along the way.

A701 - Devils Beeftub - some of the best views so far but watch the concentration and the speed! Look out for the drain covers on bends.

A708 - St Mary's Loch - Take in the scenery but remember others do the same - watch the parking areas for movement. Glen Café is worth a stop. **6**

Grey Mare's Tail Waterfalls - well worth a photo.

Moffat - Energy Top Up - try the toffee - braw! remember - bum and brain
